Did You Know?

- ★ The Neighborhood House food shelf is the largest in Ramsey County, distributing 2,500 pounds of food every day it is open.
- ★ In 2011, the food shelf served 36,426 individuals, one-half of whom were children.
- ★ 97% of food shelf participants live at or below the poverty level.
- ★ 40% of Neighborhood House participants are immigrants or refugees who have been in the United States less than four years.
